

Frontline Missions 2005

Comayagua, Honduras

June 25 - July 5

This was the largest team trip we have ever hosted with 114 people from 12 participating churches. The doors of the city were opened to us and the teams ministered in schools, streets, homes, churches and an open air youth crusade in the central park. There was a tremendous response to the gospel and in some schools every student came forward to receive Christ. We have all returned home with an increased passion for evangelism and missions.



Another exciting aspect about these trips is the relationship that is formed between the different teams. Early in the week it is easy to identify each group, but by the end of the week it is almost impossible because of the overlapping interactions of the teams. We recognize that this is a tool God is using to strengthen relationships between our churches.



Short-term missions can serve in the local church's discipleship program for training emerging leaders. During a time of worship and ministry at the conclusion of our trip, a challenge was given for those who feel God has placed a call of ministry on their lives. There was a large percentage of the group (ages 18-24) that publicly responded to the call and we are excited about the awesome potential of training and empowering the next generation of leaders.
